records stating that James Francis Moore was also a member of the company.

The places of residence for members of the company prior to the settlement in Kentucky do not necessarily indicate the states of their birth. The frequent assertion that most of Harrod's men came from the Monongahela country is clearly in error. The majority of them came from southwest Virginia, in the vicinity of Roanoke. Nor are most of the men "related by blood or marriage," as stated by Richard Henderson and others. So far as the records show, Thomas Quirk, a native of Ireland, was the only member of the company not born in this country. James Sodousky and George Poage are often listed as members of Isaac Hite's company that came into Kentucky soon after Harrod. It is possible that the Hite company had earlier agreed to join Harrod. There is also reason to believe that not all the men who had signed the Company Book came down the Ohio with Harrod. In his narrative, Abraham Chapline says that the captain waited for others to join him, but left before they arrived.
